
ETEL ADNAN, KADER ATTIA, DANIEL BUREN, PASCALE MARTHINE TAYOU INAUGURACIÓN: JUEVES, 28 DE ABRIL 2016 - 5 PM

En Cuba, se podría decir, ya no quedan espacios vacíos. En cada esquina se encuentra un objeto, en cada pared, un cuadro, un cartel o una fotografía. La decoración de muros y cornisas cambia de balcón a balcón. Rejas en puertas y ventanas se entrelazan en fantasías neoclásicas, art deco y tropicales. A lo largo de las aceras y en los parques crecen palmeras y cuelgan raíces, mientras en los patios florecen jagueyes y bougainvillas.

Tanto el eclecticismo arquitectónico de la isla, como la variedad de su naturaleza, reflejan la diversidad social. Durante siglos, las tradiciones y las culturas se encontraron y convivieron, mezclando razas y religiones. Nacieron así el espíritu y la identidad de la Isla.

Inspirada por Cuba y sus habitantes, el proyecto Arte CONTINUA, desde su primera exposición, inaugurada en noviembre de 2015, ocupa cada rincón del antiguo cine Águila de Oro, con obras de arte que, sin modificarlo, se apropián de todo el espacio. En su edificación del Barrio Chino coinciden, en este momento, tres exposiciones. A una primera muestra, *Anclados en el Territorio*, dedicada sólo a artistas cubanos, se añadieron, en enero de 2016, las obras de cuatro creadores italianos. La unión de los dos grupos se realizó bajo el nombre *TU + YO = NOSOTROS*. No obstante, esta no sería la única vez que semejante combinación ocurriría. El 28 de abril de 2016, Arte CONTINUA se transforma nuevamente, incluyendo, dentro de sus predios, las obras de los artistas francófonos de Galleria Continua. La nueva exposición, *Ensemble*, dejará una vacante a la cuarta y última etapa de este viaje: espejo y génesis de la cultura cubana. En ese momento, además de los artistas cubanos, italianos y francófonos, serán los autores de origen chino, de Galleria Continua, quienes deberán poner su ingenio en función de lidiar con la capacidad de adaptación al encontrar, no solo un espacio ya ocupado, sino prácticamente lleno.


Con la inauguración de *Ensemble* que celebra el Mes de la Cultura Francesa en Cuba (27 de abril al 31 de mayo), Arte CONTINUA invita a los artistas ETEL ADNAN, DANIEL BUREN, PASCAL MARTHINE TAYOU y KADER ATTIA a expresarse, tanto dentro de su espacio, como también fuera de sus muros.



Périmètre - Blanc (1969-2015), una instalación de Daniel Buren, durante la XII Bienal de La Habana recorría el perímetro del Águila de Oro, un cine abandonado en el corazón del Barrio Chino. Sin embargo, ahora las bandas blancas del artista ya no encuentran un espacio vacío, sino Arte CONTINUA Habana y las obras de TÚ + YO = NOSOTROS y Anclados en el Territorio.



Pascale Marthine Tayou por su parte, se apropió del muro exterior de la Embajada de Francia en Cuba, con un mural: Kamouflage. Sus cinco colores representan los cinco continentes, y sus personajes, una iconografía fantástico-tribal. En la Galería, por otro lado, suspende un "alfombra voladora" constituida con bolsas plásticas de colores.

5. **7, 14 y 21 de mayo**: Lugar de encuentro: Esquina calle San Lázaro y Prado.

10 am: Recorridos con mediador por la Habana Vieja y la calle San Lázaro para visitar Promenade à La Havane, la obra del artista francés Daniel Buren.

'ENSEMBLE'

ETEL ADNAN, KADER ATTIA, DANIEL BUREN, PASCALE MARTHINE TAYOU OPENING: THURSDAY, APRIL 28, 2016 - 5 PM

In Cuba, no spaces remain empty. In each corner lies an object, on every wall hangs a painting, a poster or a photograph. Colors on facades, cornices and windows change from balcony to balcony. Likewise, grilles and gates curl up into seemingly free motifs – Neoclassical or Art Deco regardless, they flourish from Tropical soils. On the other hand, palm trees and flying roots sprout from roadsides, and so do ficus and bougainvillea.

Somehow, the architectural eclecticism, as well as nature's exuberance, reflect the people's diversity. For centuries, traditions and cultures have layered and mingled: races and religions. The recent past has fueled solidarity within the islanders. In ancient palaces, where today live various generations of families, at night one even hears the breathing of a neighbor. By day, the same families share spaces, meals and entertainment gathered in courtyards in front of a screen or a game of dominoes.

Inspired by Cuba and its inhabitants, Arte CONTINUA, from its opening in November 2015, fills walls and floors with artworks that echo even in the air. In its space, a former cinema theater in Havana's Chinatown, three exhibitions overlap. The first show, *Anclados en el Territorio*, dedicated to Cuban artists, in January 2016 was joined by the artworks of four Italians. The union of the two groups was *YOU + ME = US*. On April 28, 2016, Arte CONTINUA expands once again including the works of Galleria Continua's Francophone artists. Whereupon, this new exhibition, *Ensemble*, will undergo the fourth and final phase of the journey, both mirror and genesis of the Cuban culture. In early summer, in addition to Cuban, Italian and Francophone artists, Galleria Continua's Chinese will deal with a space not only already busy, but practically full.

Opening *Ensemble* to celebrate the Month of French Culture in Cuba (May), Arte CONTINUA invites ETEL ADNAN, DANIEL BUREN, PASCAL MARTHINE TAYOU and KADER ATTIA to express themselves both within its space and around town.

Daniel Buren's *Périmètre - Blanc* (1969-2015) installation during Havana's XII Biennial paced the perimeter of Águila de Oro, an abandoned cinema theater at the heart of Chinatown. Today the artist's white stripes no longer find an empty space but Arte CONTINUA and the works of YOU + ME = US and Anclados en el Territorio.

Pascale Marthine Tayou embraces the French Embassy in Cuba with a mural. Whereas *Kamouflage*'s five colors represent the continents, its characters embody a phantasy-tribal iconography. In the Gallery's space, he suspends a "flying carpet" with plastic bags.
